



Guidelines for our Public Medians and Islands

Kessler Neighbors United (KNU), your neighborhood association, maintains and improves 18 City of Dallas islands, medians and the Kessler Steps under the MOWMentum agreement with the City. As the *agent* for these properties, we are contractually responsible to the City of Dallas and must ensure these greenspaces are safe, maintained and do not limit or block the line of sight for pedestrians or motor vehicles. Liability insurance is a requirement of this agreement.

The KNU board budgets and approves, all improvements to islands and medians within greater Kessler Park. Our beautification committee creates an annual beautification plan and budget, and organizes and executes all beautification efforts. KNU spends \$16,000 to \$20,000 annually for utilities and maintenance on these properties.

Neighbors are always welcomed and encouraged to volunteer to:

- Weed
- Rake leaves
- Remove trash and small fallen branches
- Participate in Beautification Days

Neighbors may not:

- Place signage of any type
- Plant
- Trim or remove dead plants
- Leave or place any debris. All debris must be bagged and removed as there is not bulk trash removal on City property

Beautification of these spaces must be approved by the City of Dallas MOWMentum department. When KNU has beautification days, we request and receive approval prior to our workday. Please reference our MOWMentum contract at.....LINK???

If you have an idea for a change or improvement, including planting or trimming, please contact the Beautification committee, beautification@kesslerneighbors.org, so your idea can be reviewed and discussed with the City of Dallas for approval.
